

York Racecourse - Going Report
Wednesday 13/08/14 at 3.30 pm

The official ground description remains Good-to-Soft, Good in places and a Goingstick reading of 6.3. Wednesday has been dry following 4mm of rain on Tuesday evening.

Current conditions on Wednesday afternoon are dry, bright and breezy – 20 degrees.

The Met Office five day forecasts through to Sunday 17 August is a mixture of bright, blustery, fresh conditions with the chance of localised, passing scattered showers.

William Derby, Chief Executive and Clerk of the Course, said at 3.30pm on Wednesday 13 August:
“The ground is slowly starting to dry out after a wet weekend in Yorkshire last weekend. The current going of Good to Soft, Good in places may dry further if we miss the showers over the next few days but it will not dry quickly as the nights are cool and the daytime temperatures are not hot. We are pleased with the condition of the racing surface with a dense, thick sward and the grass in excellent health.”
