

York Racecourse - Going Report
Thursday 14/08/14 at 3.30 pm

The official ground description has changed to Good, Good-to-Soft in places and a Goingstick reading of 6.4. It has been dry since 4mm of rain on Tuesday evening and the current conditions on Thursday afternoon are dry and cloudy.

The weather forecast for Thursday, is to be dry and bright, with a temperature of 19 degrees. The Met Office five day forecast states Thundery showers are possible late afternoon/ evening on Thursday, but it should be dry & bright on Friday and Saturday. Good sunny spells with light showers are predicted for Sunday and Monday.

Anthea Morshead, Assistant Clerk of the Course, said at 3.30pm on Thursday 14 August: "It has been a dry, mostly sunny day, and warmer than expected at 19 degrees, which had dried the course a little to Good, Good to Soft in places. It is clouding over at the moment however, and we may catch some heavy showers in the next couple of hours, which are currently to the north and east of us. The forecast though, is for it to be dry from tonight through Friday and Saturday. Sunday and Monday are mainly dry, with some passing showers and good sunny spells.

Rainfall: 20mm on Sunday 10 August, 2mm Monday, 4mm Tuesday night. Dry since.
