

York Racecourse - Going Report
Friday 15/08/14 at 6.00 am

The official ground description remains Good, Good-to-Soft in places and a Goingstick reading of 6.4. It has been dry in York since the 4mm of rain on Tuesday evening.

Current conditions on Friday morning are dry, clear, bright and fresh.

The Met Office five day forecasts through to Tuesday 19 August is to remain largely dry with broken cloud and a fresh breeze. There remains throughout the chance of localised, passing scattered showers.

William Derby, Chief Executive and Clerk of the Course, said at 6am on Friday 15 August: "The ground is slowly starting to dry out after a wet weekend in Yorkshire last weekend. The current going of Good, Good-to-Soft in places may dry further if we miss the showers over the next few days but it will not dry quickly as the nights are cool and the daytime temperatures are not hot. We missed of the showers and rain in the area on Thursday which was quite amazing as there was heavy downpours all around the wider County. We are pleased with the condition of the racing surface with a dense, thick sward and the grass in excellent health."
